Dear TEPPFA members,

Although, TEPPFA as association is not directly involved in the organization and the working of the Vinyl Foundation, we do feel it appropriate to inform you about the actual situation and the progress on short term.

**As some large TEPPFA company members are concerned:**

For reason of pre-financing the Recovynyl activities, they were (are) asked to prepay their contribution by means of a self-assessment form. Apart from the assessment form, 2 other documents could be of importance:

- the Exemption form for export outside the EU if  $\geq 10\%$  of total volume
- the Application for centralized payment

**End of April, this system of advance payments will be closed.** Those, who have not paid, will receive a payment request as mentioned below.

**As all other companies are concerned:**

End of April, the Vinyl Foundation (KPMG) will have received and collected all data from the PVC resin producers. On the basis of all these data, KPMG will send a payment request to all other companies. **This will start around the middle of May.** In case of export and/or centralized payment, documents have to be faxed to KPMG (fax nr.0032 2 7084399) **before May 15<sup>th</sup>** (see references above).

End of June, a first positive list of contributors will be released. This release will be followed by a strong communication campaign.
